NEWS-02: The Submarine Combat Patrol Insignia Submitted by: office on 3/6/2014

The Submarine Combat Patrol Insignia is a uniform breast pin worn by officers and men of the United States Navy's Submarine Service who have completed one or more war patrols that have been designated successful by the area sub force commander.

To be successful the submarine typically needed to sink at least one ship or complete a mission of comparable importance, although later in the war when targets were scarce, the rescue of allied pilots usually resulted in the designation of a successful war patrol.

The pin shows the broadside of a Gato-class submarine. A scroll beneath the submarine holds service stars, one gold star for each successful patrol after the first or a silver star for five successful patrols.

The Submarine Combat Patrol Insignia is considered a "secondary insignia" and is typically worn in conjunction with a primary warfare badge, such as the Submarine Warfare Insignia. Personnel eligible to wear other secondary insignias, such as the SSBN Deterrent Patrol Insignia or the Deep Submergence Insignia, may only wear one insignia at a time according to their personal desire.

When creating new artwork, please refer to the mechanical dimension chart above. Ad sizes falling between two dimension sets are charged at the rate of the next larger size except for minor size differences, the amount to be determined by Mare Island Base, USSVI on a case-by-case basis.

File formats: Adobe InDesign, Adobe PageMaker, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop, Adobe PDF, TIFF, JPEG (although we do not recommend the JPEG file format for this purpose). CYMK color is preferred although we can convert from RGB but any color shift in the conversion is not our responsibility.

If you have a choice, save the file in a Windows file format. Floppy disks, CDs, DVDs, & memory cards can be used or you can send the files as an attachment to an e-mail.

Continuous tone images require 300 dpi line art requires 1200 dpi for best quality. Include font files for non-raster image formats such as InDesign, PageMaker, Illustrator, etc.
