These files are in Acrobat format and everybody should have a mini-program already on your computer to read these. If you cannot, give me a call at (602) 448-3873.





2014 RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) Please keep in mind that this is a "family" parade and all entries must be "G" rated.
- Your parade position and final details will be sent June 23rd. Numbers to be prominently displayed on your entry will be issued on the morning of the parade. If your entry is a group, please be certain that all members of the group know their position number and all the necessary details prior to parade day.
- 3) Because of the number of entries in the parade and the timeframe the parade is allowed, there cannot be delays or stops to perform. In the interest of safety, throwing items (candy, gifts, etc.) from your parade entrants will only be allowed with volunteers walking close to the parade watchers.

 NO THROWING ITEMS FROM YOUR ENTRY. Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. will not be held responsible for anyone injured by violation of this rule.
- 4) Sign/Banner letters should not be larger than 18 inches. Advertising, identification of floats and themes should be kept to a minimum and be in good taste. <u>Any advertising that includes the name of a business is considered a "commercial entry" and is subject to the "commercial entry fees".</u>
- 5) All float entries MUST have fire extinguishers.
- 6) All children under the age of twelve (12) years must be accompanied by an adult. All children must be "seated" on any and all types of floats/vehicles.
- 7) Participants "standing" on a float/vehicle must have something stable to hold on to for balance.
- 8) If you will be discharging a weapon <u>Absolutely NO LIVE ROUNDS!</u>
- 9) Judging of all entries will take place during the Parade. Announcements will be made in the Sunday newspaper and sent by email to parade entrants. Parade awards may be picked up at the Prescott Frontier Days® Office starting July 7, 2014.
- 10) Consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to or during the parade will not be tolerated.
- 11) Participants should arrive at their <u>staging area</u> starting at 7:00 am to receive numbers and locate their positions.
- 12) Horse Entries: Please review the following guidelines:
 - Children under the age of twelve (12) will not be allowed to ride a horse alone during the parade; they must be accompanied by an adult walking or riding alongside.
 - All children under the age of twelve (12) riding on a horse MUST wear a protective helmet.
 - Any vehicle being pulled by a horse(s) (includes, but not limited to a wagon, stagecoach, or trailer) must have an adult walking alongside or riding with the horse(s) to help control the horse(s) throughout the parade route. A safety rope/out-rigging must be attached to the team lead to stop the team.
 - For safety reasons, only one (1) rider per horse.
 - All equine entrants should be familiar with Arizona Revised Statutes ARS 12-553 concerning Limited liability of equine owners and owners of equine facilities.

- © Entries should arrive at your <u>assigned</u> staging area by 7:00am to receive numbers and locate your positions.
 - © Once you have entered the Parade Route, you must maintain your proper speed and forward motion

THERE CANNOT BE DELAYS TO STOP AND PERFORM.

- No Water Guns Wet pavement for horses and wet people are NOT a good thing!!
 - © If you will be discharging a weapon No Live Rounds!

 - ©Candy or other items may ONLY be distributed by parade walkers at curbside along the parade route.

NO throwing items from your entry.

No Alcoholic Beverages Will Be Permitted!
