This Sunday is the 73rd anniversary of the surprise attack by the Empire of Japan on U.S. Forces (overwhelmingly Navy) in Hawaii – **Pearl Harbor Day**. 
Over 5,000 of our heritage shipmates in 51 submarines gave their all and remain on Eternal Patrol as the major force in strangling Japan and forcing its surrender.
